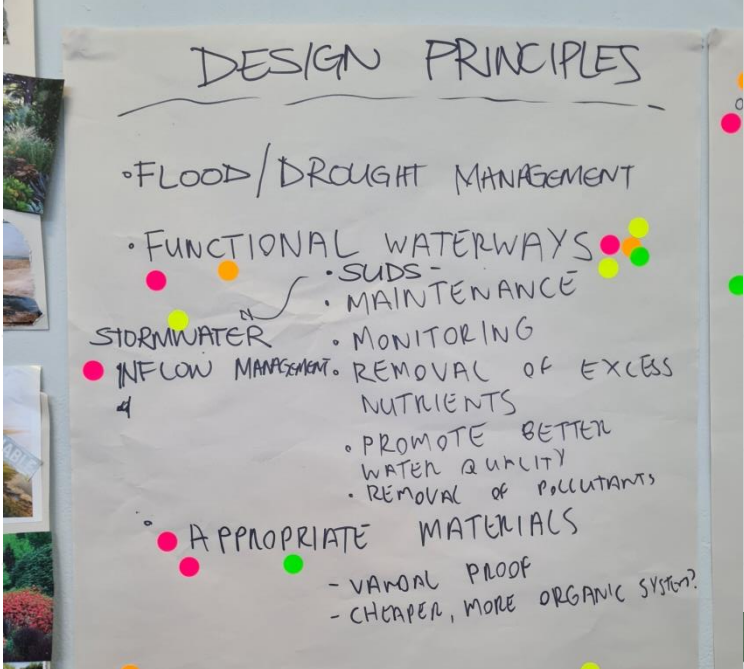

# LESSONS LEARNT
